What is this conference about?

CorrExpo is your gateway to industry trends, innovations, new products and services and so much more that is exciting and different in the corrugated packaging industry. This comprehensive event assembles the largest gathering of decision makers in the corrugated industry and is only held once a year.

CorrExpo features widely recognized speakers, seminars, workshops, exhibits and social networking events. This year's conference program will cover all areas of digital and high graphics in addition to other relevant topics related all areas of the corrugated industry.

What sessions can I attend?

The CorrExpo program is open; paid conference registrants may attend any session at any time, regardless of the topic area.

Are there any discount registrations available?

Yes. Members of TAPPI, students and industry retirees receive discounted registration rates.

In addition, if three or more co-workers from the same company register together, a group discount is available. Finally, if you work for a box plant your location can take advantage of a tier pricing structure which allows groups of employees to attend for one flat fee.

Must I register for the conference to attend committee meetings?

No. Committee meetings are open - if you are not a member of a committee and would like to attend a meeting to see what it is all about, please feel free to attend. In order to continue to participate on any committee projects or be an active member of the committee, TAPPI membership is required. TAPPI Committee meetings are an excellent way to meet colleagues and network in your area of expertise.

How do I best reach my customers during CorrExpo?

CorrExpo includes numerous coffee breaks and receptions to facilitate networking. In addition, the conference trade fair allows you to formally display your company and products/services to the industry. Breaks and lunches are held in the trade fair area. There is also an Innovation Session where exhibitors and sponsors will have the opportunity to present a short (8-minute) commercial presentation to attendees.

Do some sessions require an extra charge?

No, all sessions are included in your full conference registration. The pre-conference workshops require additional fees; see the registration page on www.correxpo.org for specific pricing.

What is the best way to get to Providence?

Rhode Island is easy to reach by air, rail or highway. Warwick's T.F. Green Airport is just 10 minutes from Providence, and Amtrak and MBTA rail service is located in the heart of downtown. Once here, Providence and Warwick offer ample car rental, limousine and charter bus options. The Rhode Island Public Transit Authority (known as RIPTA) provides convenient public bus transportation throughout the state.
