What is this conference about?

Corrugated Week is the most comprehensive corrugated event held in North America and is co-produced by TAPPI and AICC. The exhibit features over 130 suppliers all gathered under one roof to showcase their new products and services.

The event also features widely recognized speakers, seminars, workshops, exhibits and social networking events. This year's conference program will cover digital printing, robotics, automation, material handling, safety, ERP solutions and HR topics.

Who will attend Corrugated Week?

Corrugated Week attracts the world's foremost industry leaders and experts. You'll be in good company along with:

Is there anything special offered for the Young Professionals and Emerging Leaders?

Yes, there will be special workshops offered on both Tuesday and Wednesday specifically designed with the young professional in mind. There will also be a special Networking Event at Punch Bowl Social on Wednesday evening that is specifically for the Young Professionals and Emerging Leaders. There is no additional charge for the YP/EL programming but the event at Punch Bowl Social is \$200 per person.

How are the speakers selected?

The program is assembled by technical program committees from both TAPPI and AICC which are comprised of industry professionals who work in the areas being covered. The committees employ a rigorous selection and review process to assure that the presentations are of highest quality and the content is of utmost relevance and value to the industry.

What sessions can I attend?

The Corrugated Week program is open; paid conference registrants may attend any session at any time, regardless of the topic area.

Are there any discount registrations available?

Yes. Members of TAPPI or AICC, exhibitors, students and industry retirees receive discounted registration rates.

In addition, if three or more co-workers from the same company register together, a group discount is available. Finally, if you work for a box plant your location can take advantage of a tier pricing structure which allows groups of employees to attend for one flat fee.

Must I register for the conference to attend TAPPI Committee Meetings?

No. Committee meetings are open - if you are not a member of a committee and would like to attend a meeting to see what it is all about, please feel free to attend. In order to continue to participate on any committee projects or be an active member of the committee, TAPPI membership is required. TAPPI Committee meetings are an excellent way to meet colleagues and network in your area of expertise.

How do I best reach my customers during Corrugated Week?

Corrugated Week includes numerous coffee breaks and receptions to facilitate networking. In addition, on Tuesday evening there is an off-site gala at the Dallara IndyCar Factory which will be a highlight of the networking portion of the conference. This year we have expanded the popular What's New Session and moved it from being a part of the paid conference program out onto the exhibit floor to allow everyone to attend the presentations.
