

# **An In-depth look into the Bonding Process Variables for the Corrugator & Identifying Defects**

3. Determine proper heat settings including:
  - a. Proper bond windows while controlling warp
  - b. Running mismatched, lightweight and coated liners (Kemi)
  - c. Starch applicator lag speeds
  - d. Inlet paper temperatures for the doublebacker
  - e. An understanding of doublebacker zone temperatures and ballast or shoe loading for best combined board moisture and bond
  - f. What effect the doublebacker belt has and recent applications
  - g. How to deal with various board grades
  - h. How to read the board and understanding defects
